## Payment Process for Nursery

Charges incurred for the nursery can be paid in the following ways:-

1. Online – Please use the details below:-

Bank - Lloyds Bank

Account Number - 19341368

Sort code - 30-80-12

A payment reference needs to be added to the online transaction. This must include the name of the child and what the payment is for, e.g.

PeterWoottonNurseryCare to be used for additional sessions and for lunchtime cover between sessions (30 minutes)

PeterWoottonNurseryLunch to be used for school lunches at a cost of £2.30 per meal

Separate payments need to be made for Care and Lunches.

Any trips can also be paid this way with a similar reference, PeterWoottonTrip

**2. By cheque** Please make cheques payable to Oxfordshire County Council or OCC. Please ensure that you write on the back of the cheque what the cheque is for e.g. Nursery Care £10.00, Nursery Lunches £11.50

**3. By cash** Please ensure that cash is placed inside an envelope and that the child's name is clearly written on the front with the same reference details as above e.g. Nursery Care £10.00.
