#### The Queen's Platinum Jubilee.

#### Change to the last day of the Summer Term

As you may be aware, an extra bank holiday has been announced for 3rd June 2022 for the Queen's Platinum Jubilee.

As on previous similar occasions (eg the 2012 Diamond Jubilee or 2011 Royal Wedding), the DfE has therefore amended the Education (School Day and School Year) (England) Regulations to reduce the school year 2021/22 for maintained schools to a minimum of 189 days, in order to allow schools to close that day or on another. School will, however, be on half term at the time of the bank holiday. This change to the Regulations means that schools are able to close at another time to give staff and students an extra day off.

Therefore we have decided to bring the end of the summer term forward by one day. The new end date of the summer term will be **Wednesday 20 July at 1:30 pm.**

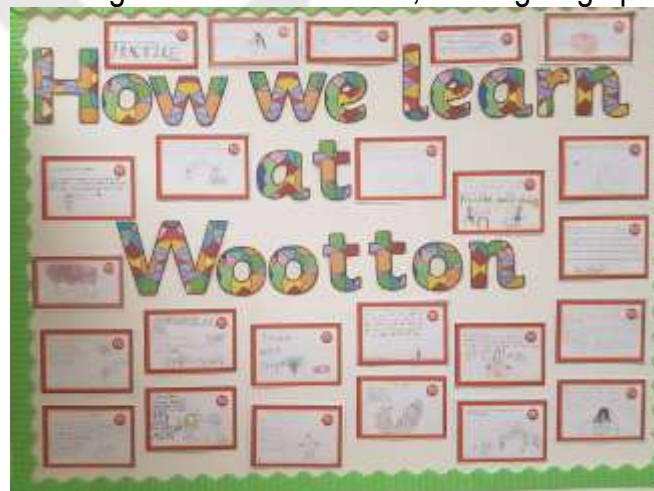
